We also have had a generous endowment from the Hoffmann Family for our future. We have had many positive comments from the city and the possibility of applying for some terrific grants, the spot is on the bus route, the utilities are already in place, so we thought this is a perfect time for us to buy this property and build a more suitable senior center.

Since we are over 550 members strong, the Board has decided that we are going to be an all-volunteer organization. The decisions will be made by the Board and the committees will be in charge of all activities, fundraisers, classes and events.


