# Message from the Board

#### OVERVIEW OF EXPENSES FOR THE NEW FORTUNA SENIOR CENTER

**LAND:** Purchase price is \$250.000. Good faith deposit of \$2,500 was submitted to Escrow at Humboldt Land Title Co. Our contract with Wendt Trust is conditioned on the following: Lot split will be completed and approved by Fortuna Planning Commission and City Council. Once this is approved, Fortuna Senior Center will pay an additional \$47,500 and sign a note and deed of trust for the remaining \$200,00 with equal payments of \$50.00 due every three months for one year with no interest. Technically, the FSC will become the owner of the lot on signing the note and deed of trust. Closing costs for Escrow will be split 50/50 between buyer and seller.

**BUILDING:** To date, we have paid Whitchurch Engineering \$2,000. for the initial design and layout of the building. The first plan was unacceptable to the committee. We then found the building could be located on the east side of the lot, allowing for a different exterior dimension. By changing the dimensions, we were able to accomplish a much better layout. So we started with a very talented draftsman, Guy Kitahara, who works closely with Whitchurch Engineering, and was recommend by Mr. Whitchurch. Guy has given us a site plan, floor plan and now elevations which complete our preliminary plans. If these are accepted by the Board, we will then go to Whitchurch Engineering and a representative of a metal building manufacturer for both the building and the government regulations regarding development of bare land.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT? The lot split application has been submitted to Fortuna Planning Department and is currently being reviewed by all applicable City departments. After this, a public notice is given and the item is placed on the Planning Commission Agenda. Assuming it passes the Commission, it then goes to the city Council for final approval. The seller is responsible for all costs associated with the lot split. Tentatively, we expect to be on the Planning Commission agenda for September 8.

Assuming we gain approval of the Planning Commission and City Council, we then start the process of meeting with representatives of the metal building manufacturer and with Whitchurch engineering. This will lead to a more accurate cost of the project.


