months for the land purchase but it should have read \$50,000 every 3 months making it a total of


\$250,000. We have the money put aside for this purchase.

NEW BUILDING UPDATE October 21, 2020

We continue to move through the bureaucratic processes of the City, seeking a lot split by Wendt Trust and Wright (legal owners). At the request of the City, we have updated our plans for a use permit consideration for the lot. We should be in the final stages of City staff work when we are scheduled to go before the Planning Commission and then the City Council. Overall, the changes have been minimal but they all take time and effort to complete.

Assuming we succeed with the lot split, use permit and any other City/State regulations or requirements, we will then move on to working with an engineering firm and will have to select a contractor that erects metal buildings. Hopefully, that will go smoothly and soon we may have more accurate estimates of the final cost for our new home.

We continue to receive positive feedback from members of Fortuna Senior Center and others who are aware of our efforts to find a permanent home.


Yes, these are golf balls dropping out of the sky!!! Tickets are \$20.00.
