## **NEW BUILDING UPDATE**

We have acquired a piece of ground for our new center and we have a plan (see below) of what the new center will look like.

Now begins the work of turning the concept into a reality.

I should state that, technically, we do not have the deed for the new lot as we have been waiting for the final map to be checked, rechecked and checked again and then it must be recorded with the County Recorder. All this is tough enough at any time, but now, throw in a pandemic, Christmas and the New Year holidays and you can see why things are lagging. But the map is now ready to be recorded. In the meantime, we have been given permission to place our sign on the lot and we have happily done so. Check it out at the corner of Rohnerville Rd and Gulliksen.

The next step is having plans drawn so that we are able to get bids for all the work that must be accomplished. We are happy to be this far along but we obviously have a ways to go. Hang in there!

The latest update: We have an estimated price for the 7700 square foot building... 1.5 million dollars!!!




### **BOOKS AND PUZZLES AND PUZZLES AND BOOKS!!**

As you know, the Fortuna Senior Center Board is moving forward as quickly as possible to construct a new facility on Rohnerville Rd. The new stimulus check just passed by Congress comes at an ideal time to give a significant portion (if not all) of the stimulus payment you will soon receive. If half of the current membership were to donate their payment, this would add \$140,000 to our budget, bringing us significantly closer to being able to meet the current development and future sustainability needs.


